Following his residency, Dr. Wessling completed a foot and ankle fellowship at Miami Ankle Foot International Associates at Doctors Hospital in Miami, FL, followed by a sports medicine fellowship at Lenox Hill Hospital in New York City. During his training, Dr. Wessling participated in the care of athletes from the New York Jets, New York Islanders, Miami Dolphins, Manhattanville College and Hunter College.

In the 1970s, Dr. Nicholas founded an institute dedicated to the study of sports medicine and trauma at Lenox Hill Hospital, the first hospital-based facility in the country that was devoted to this field, known today as the Nicholas Institute of Sports Medicine and Athletic Trauma (NISMAT) (www.NISMAT.ORG).
